## **Detailed Description**

### **Participants**

***The working language of the camp will be English. A sufficient command of English is therefore necessary to benefit from the camp.***

*It is not necessary to be a member of People to People International (PTPI) to take part in this event.*

### **Costs**

The **participation fee** of 200 Euros for Western Europeans and 120 Euros for Central and Eastern Europeans includes accommodation, board and all activities during the camp. The fee is due upon arrival. Advance payments are not necessary. Accommodation will be in the guest house of the Regens-Wagner-Foundation, situated immediately on the lake. The camp will start on July 29 (Sunday) in the afternoon and ends on August 7 after breakfast. The cost for travel to Balatonmáriafürdő and back is **not included** in the participation fee.

### **Application**

*The **application form** should be completed and sent to PTPI Pécs by fax or postal service no later than **May 31, 2007**. Candidates will be selected according to their motivation as it becomes evident in the application form and English language skills. All applicants will be informed within two weeks after the deadline if they have been selected or not. Travel arrangements should only be made after PTPI has officially confirmed participation. We will have a **waiting list** for those wanting to participate but exceeding the limit set for participants from the different regions in case there should be cancellations.*

### **Cancellation**

**We ask applicants to inform PTPI immediately if they are not able to attend.**
